Tax Relief Notes

IFTA carriers are exempt from the Georgia motor fuel tax between **March 18th, 2022** through **July 14, 2022** and are exempt from the Maryland fuel taxes between **March 18th, 2022** through **April 16th, 2022**.

For carriers purchasing fuel in Maryland and Georgia, fuel purchased during these tax free periods will be reported in your summary gallons, block **1B** for paper filers and **Total Gallons Consumed in all Jurisdictions** for Revenue Online filers. This information is required to calculate an accurate MPG for the period. Do not include the tax-free gallons in the Tax-Paid Gallons detail per jurisdiction.

Tax Rate Update

Due to the passage of [Senate Bill 21-260](#), effective July 1, 2022, the price of diesel and biodiesel fuel will include a new fee in addition to the fuel tax. The bridge and tunnel impact fee is 2¢ per gallon and increases the diesel and biodiesel rates from 20.5¢ to 22.5¢. The road usage fee will be effective on April 1, 2023 at 2¢ per gallon. The road usage fee will increase the gasoline, gasohol, ethanol, methanol, E-85, M-85, and A-85 rates from 22¢ to 24¢ and increase the diesel and biodiesel rates from 22.5¢ to 24.5¢. Both fees will increase annually each July. For more information go to tax.colorado.gov/fuel-fee-surcharge. You do not need to do anything; starting with the 3Q2022 period, these fees will be included in the tax rates.

2Q22 IFTA Tax Returns are due August 1, 2022

- **To file by paper:** Go to Tax.Colorado.gov/IFTA-forms to download the [current form, DR 0122](#), and the **2Q22 tax rates**. Tax rates are updated each quarter, so please select the appropriate return and rate table.
- **Or use Revenue Online:** Go to colorado.gov/revenueonline and complete your return online.
 - The Department highly recommends using Revenue Online; tax rates are updated automatically, it performs many of the calculations for you, checks for several common filing errors and eliminates the possibility of returns getting lost.
 - **New to Revenue Online:** Visit Colorado.gov/RevenueOnline and choose "Sign Up". Information to set up your online account is on your IFTA license.
